

Microsoft Windows Vista, Office 2007, and Internet Explorer (IE) 7 Release

Microsoft Windows Vista, Office 2007 and IE 7 are not certified to work with the Oracle Self-Serve and Financial Applications, Discoverer, and Application Desktop Integrator (ADI). ITS is in the process of testing these products with Oracle, Discoverer, ADI and other job-related applications. The main purpose of this effort has been to identify areas of potential impact to the RIT computing environment, conduct tests on the suite of supported applications, document compatibility issues, and list applications that are not currently supported by Windows Vista, Office 2007 and IE 7. As long as job-related applications are not certified to work with these products, ITS recommends postponing installing or upgrading office computers with Windows Vista, Office 2007 or IE 7. Departments run the risk of incompatibility issues by upgrading to these products at this time.

For those departments purchasing new computers, ITS suggests ordering Vista ready as opposed to already installed.
